

Cleaning and Disinfecting Virtual Care Equipment in Health Care Organizations

This guide provides information on cleaning and disinfecting virtual care equipment in health care organizations.

Health Canada is working with disinfectant manufacturers and industry associations to better inform Canadians of the products available for use to help against the spread of infections during the COVID-19 outbreak¹.

Coronaviruses are enveloped viruses. This means they are one of the easiest types of viruses to kill with the appropriate disinfectant product when used according to the label directions¹.
