Telemedicine allows me to see patients from multiple communities in a short period of time. When new symptoms arise, I want to be available for my patients. Connecting via telemedicine is the perfect way to see patients and determine if they should travel to Thunder Bay for further investigations or treatment. Sometimes they are better cared for in their home communities and telemedicine allows patients to receive quality cancer care close to home.”
